

HATTIE McFRAZIER



HATTIE McFRAZIER, was born and raised in a family of six in a small, rural town in Northern Louisiana. Hattie attended Southern University in Baton Rouge, LA where she received her B.S. in Social Science and a M.S. in Social Science and Curriculum. She has 31 years of service as an educator for the Los Angeles Unified School District. Mrs. McFrazier always puts the needs of others first and has had a lasting impact on people of all ages and backgrounds. She dedicates herself to causes she is truly passionate about and is family-

oriented, a mentor, friend, bold with firm beliefs, shaped by southern roots; a strong, assertive, and gifted woman. Hattie is a community and union activist who has served on many committees, councils and boards. She is the past Far West Regional Director of the National Sorority of Phi Delta Kappa, Inc., serves on the Board of Trustees as well as past national youth coordinator, regional and local youth coordinator of NSPDK. She believes that, as quoted by Albert Einstein, "Only a life lived for others is a life worthwhile."



2017 NATIONAL CITATION AWARD RECIPIENT

DR. RODERICK L. SMOTHERS



DR. RODERICK L. SMOTHERS, SR. was named 14th president of Philander Smith College on October 1, 2014 and officially began his tenure on January 5, 2015. Dynamic scholar, transformative leader and forward-thinking visionary, Smothers is committed to building upon the institution's strong and historic legacy, while advancing its mission to new levels of excellence. As a higher education professional, he is also experienced in conducting scientific and applied research, facilitating data-driven, community-based interventions, and training educators aspiring to leadership roles in elementary and

secondary school administration. Research agenda includes: the past, present and future of historically black colleges and universities; the transformation of toxic urban school districts, strengthening the secondary and post-secondary educational pipelines for African-American males, effective mentoring programs, the access dilemma in higher education for minority students, and the effectiveness of state merit-based tuition programs.

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT KEYNOTE SPEAKER

CHELONNDA SEROYER, M.ED.



Chelonnda Seroyer began her educational career as a high school English teacher in Madison, AL. She used Dr. Wong's book, The First Days of School, as an "instruction manual" to set up her classroom. At the end of her first year of teaching she was awarded the "Bob Jones First Year Patriot Award". At the end of her second year of teaching she was awarded the "Patriot Award." This award is given to a faculty member in recognition of valuable contributions, dedication, and service to the educational community. At

the end of her fourth year of teaching, the first year that she was eligible because she was newly tenured, she received the "Teacher of the Year" award. Chelonnda was an executive member of the Madison City School's New Teacher Induction Team where she, along with central staff personnel, coordinated the induction program for new teachers coming into the school system.

Along with her school based contributions, Chelonnda has worked with universities. The University of Alabama in Huntsville has selected her to be a member of the Education Department's Community Advisory Council. This committee is a sounding board and advisory group for issues related to the preparation and support of highly qualified teachers.

In 2007 Chelonnda received the Toyota International Teacher Award, presented to 40 teachers around the country. The teachers traveled to Japan for an educational study tour of the country and its educational system. While in Japan, she was featured on the Japanese national news station discussing her plans to bring the Japanese culture into her classroom.

Chelonnda has presented with Dr. Harry Wong for organizations such as, the New Jersey Association for Supervision and Curriculum Development (ASCD), the Texas Teachers Alternative Certification Program, the North Carolina Model Teacher Education Consortium. She has done keynote presentations for Dr. Bill Daggett's International Center for Leadership in Education's Model Schools Conferences. In addition to their US appearances, she travels with Harry and Rosemary Wong around the world including their latest trip to Hong Kong. She is one of the featured teachers in Dr. Wong's online classroom management course and her complete story was featured in a February 2005, www.teachers.net column. Chelonnda is also featured on a DVD in the new 4th edition of The First Days of School.

She has done solo presentations nationally and internationally for various school districts including Puerto Rico, Hawaii, St. Thomas, St. Croix, and Canada. She has also worked with new teacher programs such as the National Aeronautics Space Administration's (NASA) Pre-Service Teacher Institute and the Miami-Dade County School District's Summer Inservice program.

TANANARIVE DUE



Tananarive Due is a former Cosby Chair in the Humanities at Spelman College (2012-2014), where she taught screenwriting, creative writing and journalism. also teaches in the creative writing MFA program at Antioch University Los Angeles. The American Book Award winner and NAACP Image Award recipient is the author of twelve novels and a civil rights memoir. 2010, she was inducted into the Medill School of Journalism's Hall of Achievement at Northwestern University.

Due's novella "Ghost Summer," published in the 2008 anthology The Ancestors, received the 2008 Kindred Award from the Carl Brandon Society, and her short fiction has appeared in best-of-the-year anthologies of science fiction and fantasy. Due is a leading voice in black speculative fiction; a paper on Due's work recently was presented at the College Language Association (CLA) Conference. Due also wrote The Black Rose, a historical novel about the life of Madam C.J. Walker, based on the research of Alex Haley – and Freedom in the Family: A Mother-Daughter Memoir of the Fight for Civil Rights, which she co-authored with her mother, the late civil rights activist Patricia Stephens Due. Freedom in the Family was named 2003's Best Civil Rights Memoir by Black Issues Book Review. (Patricia Stephens Due took part in the nation's first "Jail-In" in 1960, spending 49 days in jail in Tallahassee, Florida, after a sit-in at a Woolworth lunch counter.)

In 2004, alongside such luminaries as Nobel Prize-winner Toni Morrison, Due received the "New Voice in Literature Award" at the Yari Yari Pamberi conference co-sponsored by New York University's Institute of African-American Affairs and African Studies Program and the Organization of Women Writers of Africa.

LITTLE ROCK NINE •

ELIZABETH ANN ECKFORD



Elizabeth Ann Eckford made history as a member of the Little Rock Nine, the nine African-American students who desegregated Little Rock Central High School in 1957. The image of fifteen-year-old Eckford, walking alone through a screaming mob in front of Central High School, propelled the crisis into the nation's living rooms and brought international attention to Little Rock (Pulaski County). Eckford was awarded the prestigious Spingarn Medal by the National Association

for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP), as were the rest of the Little Rock Nine and Daisy Bates, in 1958. In 1997, Elizabeth Eckford shared the Father Joseph Biltz Award (presented by the National Conference for Community and Justice) with Hazel Bryan Massery, a segregationist classmate who appears in the famous Will Counts photograph, and during the reconciliation rally of 1997, the two former adversaries made speeches together.

THELMA MOTHERSHED WAIR



Thelma Jean Mothershed Wair made history as a member of the Little Rock Nine, the African-American students involved in the desegregation of Little Rock Central High School in 1957. The world watched as they braved constant intimidation and threats from those who opposed desegregation of the formerly all-white high school. Mothershed was a junior when she entered Central. Despite the fact that she had a cardiac condition since birth, she had a near perfect record for

attendance. Mothershed attended Dunbar Junior High School and Horace Mann High School before transferring to Central High. Despite daily tormenting from some white students at Central High, she completed her junior year at the formerly all-white high school during the tumultuous 1957–58 year. Because the city's high schools were closed the following year, Mothershed earned the necessary credits for graduation through correspondence courses and by attending summer school in St. Louis, Missouri. She received her diploma from Central High by mail. The National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP) awarded her and the other Little Rock Nine, along with Daisy Bates, the prestigious Spingarn Medal in 1958.
