2021 Conference Observers Committee Report

Contained herein is the summary and legacy of the 2021 Conclave of National Sorority of Phi Delta Kappa, Inc.

Conference Theme: “Bold 21st Century Education: A Global Perspective”

Engaging with technology to accomplish the goals of hosting the 98th Virtual Anniversary Conclave was paramount in every aspect of conference planning for the Supreme Basileus, Executive Council, Conclave Coordinators, and the Host Chapter, Beta Xi, of Orlando Florida – Southeast Region.

This hybrid conference experience was enhanced by the computer platform Whova. The event planning app provided many interactive features allowing participants to interact with sorors from across each of the five regions by using their desktops, laptops, tablets, and smartphones. In addition to using the app to register for conclave, sorors had fun chatting, posting pictures, discussing various topics, praying, and taking part in challenges enabling them to compete for bragging rights.

The Whova app was helpful in syncing the conclave schedule to sorors' devices with regular reminders of upcoming activities. Additionally, the app was user friendly enabling sorors to see the conference agenda in two formats: The full conference agenda and a personalized agenda of a soror's daily activity selections – which sorors were able to print. Other app features included: A sessions link for each day listing the events and links for the day; a speakers link to read about workshop presenters; a candidates link to view campaign material of those running for National office; a business card link to connect with other registered sorors; a vendors link where sorors could still shop until they dropped — even at a virtual conference; and finally, a documents link where sorors could access conference materials and handouts.

Whova succeeded in marketing the 98th Conclave and branding National Sorority of Phi Delta Kappa, Inc.

The theme of Conclave: “**Bold 21st Century Education: A Global Perspective**”, contained four sub-themes:

- **A Global Perspective of Chapter and Community**
- **A Global Perspective of Church and State**
- **Global Influences in Education**
- **NSPDK Globally Moving Forward**

This 98th Anniversary Conclave marks another first for the sorority, the first National KOT Conference. Kappa Omicron Tau campaigned and elected National Officers who will be known as the KOT Executive Council. The KOT Vital Issues Meeting centered on the timely discussion of the 1619 Project and African American Instruction.

Pre-Conference Activities: A Global Perspective of Chapter and Community —

Workshops were plentiful giving sorors a huge selection to choose from in the areas of Leadership Training and Professional Development. Officers' workshops keyed in on sorority operations and programs. The smorgasbord of Professional Development Workshops ran concurrently leaving sorors with tough decisions to make in narrowing down their choice(s). The knowledge and expertise of NSPDK sorors were on full display as these sorors imparted invaluable PD to support sorors with their careers, chapters, social and emotional well-being.

An Evening With the Anthropos took an introspective and quite personal look into 'Exploring Black Maleness in America'. Sorors got to listen as Black men, the Men in Our Lives, had a frank discussion of their experiences being a Black man. After viewing the film 'Burden', sorors were able, in this virtual setting, to hear from our Anthropos, as they talked about the vulnerability they feel in their daily interactions as men.

Beta Xi Chapter, Orlando, Florida – presented the Community Service Award of \$4,000.00 to Ivey Lane Elementary School for the school's N.O.B.L.E. Knights Incentive Program. Mr. Samuel Danner, Principal, received the gift from National Sorority of Phi Delta Kappa, Inc., pledging that the money is an investment for the students and in the community of Ivey Lane.

A Global Perspective of Church and State:

Minister Marquise McMiller, a faculty member of Jones High School in Orlando, Florida delivered the Worship Service Message. His sermon came from 2 Corinthians 4:1-2, 7:10 and his topic was, “The Power to Preserve – Excellence Does Not Come Without Challenge”. Min. McMiller offered three points to encourage the pursuit of excellence.

- Power of Preservation — stating that the students are our ministry.
- Be bold in your messaging.
- God will Persevere (it's of God, not of us)

During the Public Meeting, sorors and community members received accolades for their achievements and accomplishments. Host Chapter, Beta Xi, presented the Trailblazer Award to two deserving trailblazers of Orlando, Florida. Orange County Mayor, Jerry Demings and Superintendent of Orange County Public Schools, Dr. Barbara Jenkins, received the recognition for being leaders in education and politics and carving a path for others to follow.

Congresswoman Val Demings received the National Citation Award.

Soror Evelyn Wright (Delta Kappa Chapter, Far West) received the National Achievement Award.

The N.A.A.C.P. Silver Life Memberships were awarded to two members of the Executive Council: for 2020 – Supreme Basileus-Elect Margarett Galloway and 2021 – 2nd Supreme Anti-Basileus Myrna Robinson.

The theme for Vital Issues, “**Dreaming Black to the Future: Encouraging Our Students to Dream of A Future for Themselves**”, featured the daughters of three Supreme Basilei and the daughter of a Past Eastern Regional Director. Dr. Carla Carter (Dr. Etta F. Carter #26), Janelle Williams Hughes (Charlotte M. Williams #25), Dr. Melva Black (Ann D. Black #23), and Dr. Monifa Oni Johnson (Drusilla M. Kinzonzi, Eastern Regional Director 2011-2015). This panel of First Daughters joined Keynote Speaker – Ytasha L. Womack to discuss helping students of color envision the endless possibilities and opportunities in a future world that they can help create.

The panelists agree that the times we’re living in, make you question your own future, well-being, and the impact on mental, physical and social well-being.

GALA was all the way ‘live’ and even a little raucous as sorors cheered for their HBCUs and the Divine 4. Regional tributes were made to the HBCUs in each of the regions.

Global Influences in Education:

The Opening Ceremony of the 98th Virtual Anniversary Conclave, acknowledged and honored the Indigenous Nations, people, and elders (past and present) whose lands are occupied by chapters in each of the five regions of NSPDK, Inc. Also acknowledged was the exploitation of Africans in the development and economy of America.

The Supreme Basileus received permission from an elder in each of the five regions to officially begin the business of the 98th National Conclave.

Dr. Mary Frances Early took the sorority oath and pledge as the 16th National Honorary Member. Dr. Early is the first Black student to graduate from the University of Georgia and is recognized for her work in education and Civil Rights.

Diamond and Life Members were presented as well as recognition of 25 and 50 year members.

The Supreme Basileus proclaims that the status of National Sorority of Phi Delta Kappa, Incorporated is that “All is well and it is good”. Membership has grown with 295 new sorors joining in 2021. Currently, there are 3,271 financial members.

The 27th Supreme Basileus, Margarett Galloway – Alpha Rho Chapter, was sworn in as were other Executive Council Officers for 2021-2025.

Dr. Etta F. Carter stated that we cannot stay stagnant and live in a world of change.

Dr. Carter reminded members of the elevator speech she introduced at the 96th Anniversary Conclave. The question she asks now is, “Do we have a Founders’ spirit of legacy?” She charged members with, “If you want to keep the momentum going, develop your speech, you’ll be surprised who’s listening.”

A follow-up question posed By Dr. Carter is, “Pin Your Legacy. What are you leaving behind for the next generation?”

Globally Moving Forward:

In conclusion, Dr. Carter reflects that if it had not been for a crisis, we would not know what we could do. This virtual conference experience was made possible because of the commitment of the Production / Tech Team working overtime and around the clock to make sure this conference would happen.

Therefore, the sorors of National Sorority of Phi Delta Kappa, Inc. extend our heartfelt gratitude for all that went into bringing a hybrid 98th National Anniversary Conclave to our mobile devices and for the sisterly patience extended to assure that no soror was left out or left behind. As the conference theme implies, NSPDK, Inc. sees the bigger picture of the future as we continue 'Boldly moving forward' together.

RULES TO GOVERN THE 2021 VIRTUAL CONCLAVE PROCEEDINGS

The proceedings for our 98th Conclave will be conducted VIRTUALLY, using previously advertised platforms as referenced from Robert's Rules of Order, 12th Edition.

Statement of Intent: The National Sorority of Phi Delta Kappa, Incorporated is comprised of professional women educators. It is our duty to these women by an action and agreement.

DELEGATE SECTIONS

1. The **PROCEEDINGS** is required to start at 10:00 a.m. and events can begin on time. (Starts on time in at least 15 minutes (15) to thirty (30) minutes early. Receive other directions from the technology team.)
2. Only users who are **officially registered** and confirmed by the technology team will be allowed attendance during business sessions. Accessibility to the technology team will be available for any needed adjustments.
3. All **assignments** shall be submitted to the Supreme Basileus in writing on the **chat box**. Please indicate name and chapter when entering information.
4. The **chat box** during sessions will ONLY be used to submit business information.
5. Please observe all **protocols** during **business sessions**, **workshops**, **special programs**, **banquets** from conversation on phones while in attendance to these events.
6. Please request users who have permission to speak. Refrain from disruptive conversations. Any registered user may participate in discussion when recognized by the presiding officer. (Refer to R21 below.)
7. All users must comply with the **Website Acceptable Use Policy** as stated in our Manual of Policies and Procedures, especially as it relates to media postings.
8. Please stop video if you must utilize hand or screen signs during sessions or events.
9. We request that only **senior citizens (65 and/or 60+)** be seen for various events. For **PUNJURY SESSIONS**, **RESOURCES ATTITUDE** is suggested, unless some other thematic attire is suggested. For **SOCIAL EVENTS**, **business**, **dress**, **casual**, **jeans**, **shorts**, **skirts**, **shirts** are suggested. For **LEISURE EVENTS**, sports attire may be worn. Attire for **open life members** is **unintegrated WHITE** at the **Member's Banquets**, for **Resolute Convention**, **UNINTERRUPTED WHITE** for **ALL**, (the include jewelry, shoes - white, neutral or natural beauty).
10. Applicable celebration gestures should be withheld after reporting of election results. An announced time will be allowed for celebration.

DELEGATE SECTIONS

11. One sign of the guest will be used only to begin and end Conclave. It is **NOT** intended to maintain order.
12. Delegates will sign in prior to opening of sessions and placed in a waiting room by the technology team. Only **delegates** need to be seated in the assigned section. Each chapter will be assigned two (2) seats in the official delegate section. Only voting delegates or their official alternate as established by the Credentials Committee will be submitted by the technology team to the delegate section, noted by chapters, during each business session.
